Performed for Princes Diana, Virgil Fox Memorial, 10th anniversary of the Walt Disney Concert Hall Organ and continues concertizing worldwide. Williams loves traveling with her husband, composing, performing and filming. Carol is most popular as a classical artist and brings a new experience to the typical solo Organ concert with her unique registrations, elegance and exceptional charismatic personality.
